Volunteer program

The Raja Ampat Research and Conservation Centre (RARCC) welcome volunteers willing to support the community and work for conservation in Raja Ampat. If you think your talents and skills can be useful for the local people and to protect fauna and flora in West Papua, please send us your volunteer application explaining your purpose.

Application process:

Please send us your resume, your motivation letter explaining what value your work will offer to our NGO, your volunteer plan and possible schedule. Projects for less than 2 months and more than 6 months won't be accepted.

Costs:

<u>Visa</u>: All the volunteers should work here under the required visa. Tourist visas won't be accepted. The RARCC will provide the paperwork needed, but the volunteer must support the cost (approximately 150 USD/month) by himself/herself.

Accommodation: €45/day

<u>Food</u>: meals can be prepared by the volunteer workers by themselves at the RARCC kitchen, but the food cost plus 20% for logistic and administrative fees must be paid by the volunteers. As an alternative, the volunteers may eat at Sorido Bay Resort for 15Eur/day (subject to availability in correspondence with Papua Diving Resorts).

Free drinking water, Internet access and diving (depending on the availability of the boats).

If the RARCC board of directors considers your volunteer plan in line with the RARCC work and needs at that time, no expenses will be charged.
